## **OLP Sector in Spain**

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## 1. Introduction

The Spanish Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (MAPA) says that the policies to promote agro-food product quality, as an alternative for Rural Development, have been the focus of constant attention in series of EU documents and regulations in recent years. Furthermore, the deliberations of the scientific community on the future of agriculture and agro-food system in European Union place quality at the centre of the global project that is to shape the future of Rural Society (MAPA, 2000). Consumers are increasingly demanding food product of higher quality according to different attributes: origin, variety, and method of production. Spain was one of the pioneers to introduce the concept of "Denominación de Origen" in the Wine Act (1932) to promote quality wines produced in some specific geographical area. The current Act that regulates those products is the Ley 25/1970, Estatuto de la Viña, del vino y de los alcoholes). The protection figures under this regulation are:

**Denomination of Origin (DO):** define as the name of the region, municipality or village used to designate a product coming from the mentioned area that has attributes and characteristics which differs from products not from this area. These differences are due to the specific method of production used in this area. Examples: Denomination of Origin "Jamón de Guijuelo" in ham, Denominations of Origin "Baena" or "Les Garrigues" in olive oil.

**Specific Denomination (DE):** is a name referred to the geographical area where the product is produced, to the race of the animal or, to the method of production for those products produced in a particular area which determine the specificity of the product. Examples: Specific Denomination "Asparagus of Navarre", or "Ternera Gallega", or "Ternasco de Aragón".

**Generic Denomination:** is used to define groups of products with similar characteristics due to the nature or the method of production. Under this designation was included the organic farming in 1988, before the European Organic production regulation was introduced in 1991. Organic farming, defined by regulation, is a way of production process, which excludes the use of synthesised chemical products. It is based on a global concept, which relies on value such as health, respect of environment, authenticity, animal care and welfare, social life, and other healthy aspects. In Spain, the Autonomous Communities (CCAA) have the competences of control and inspection of organic production. Then the CCAA have their own Regulatory Body (for control, inspection and certification): for example CRAE in Aragon, CCPAE in Catalonia, CAAE in Andalusia, COPAE in Asturias, etc.

In 1992 the European Regulation 2081/92 on the protection of the Geographic Indications and Denominations of Origin was approved (together with the Regulation 2082/92, of 14 of July, relative to the certification of the specific characteristics of agricultural products and nutritional agricultural products). The European Union sets up systems to assess and protect geographic designations and traditional specialities within the framework of agricultural and food product quality policy. Those protected figures are:

**Protected Designation of Origin (PDO):** Name of a region or specific place used to designate an agricultural or food product originating there from, which has a quality or characteristics due to the geographical medium in which production, processing and preparation take place.

**Protected Geographic Indication (PGI):** Geographical name of a region or specific place used to designate an agricultural or food product which possesses a reputation that may be attributed to said geographical origin, where at least production or processing and preparation shall have taken place.

**Traditional Speciality Guaranteed (TSG):** Agricultural or food products with specific characteristics, which are differentiated from other similar products, belonging to the same category, either through having been produced from traditional raw materials, or else through having a traditional composition or a traditional method of production and/or processing.

The existing Spanish Geographic protected signals (Ley 25/1970, Estatuto de la viña, del vino y de los alcoholes) were very similar in essence to these new European protected definitions, therefore, in 1994, one Spanish regulation was approved which adapted the Spanish regulation to the European one. One important aspect in the Spanish regulation and management of the Designation of Origin is the allocation of competences between the National and the Regional Government. While, the National Government is in charge of providing the general legal framework for the Designations

of Origin, the Autonomous regions are in charge of the application of this regulation. It means that the approval of a new Designation of Origin is taken in the Region but it must be ratified by the Central Government that is in charge of the submission to the Registration in the EU as a protected food name.

Apart from those quality designations in Spain can be found other different quality signals:

**Collective Quality Brands:** The Spanish Law of Brands (Ley de Marcas, 1988) defines a collective protection figure which is very similar to the Designation of Origin. This Law gives the possibility to create collective brands based on the origin characteristics of the product. In this case, a group of producers, retailers and also the regional administration can apply for the recognition of one of those labels for a product with some specific characteristics (origin, method of production, etc.). To get the approval they must accomplished some requirements defined in this Law, but usually, those requirements are not as strict as the requirements in the Designation of Origin Regulation. Most of the Autonomous Communities (CCAA) have established figures of protection for some of their typical products.

For instance in Cataluña they have the "Marca de Qualita" (<http://www.gencat.es/darp/mq.htm>) and in the Basque Country the "Euskal Kalitatea" (<http://mipagina.euskaltel.es/ormazabal/euskalokela.html>).

**CLARA Program:** In 1996, after the first BSE crisis in Great Britain, INTERVAC (Inter-professional Confederation of beef cattle) led a quality program "C.L.A.R.A." (meaning "beef free from additives, regulated and endorsed programme") (noted that CLARA means CLEAR). This is the first integrated Spanish system dealing explicitly with the safety of beef in the supply chain. It is a control program for beef in order to give guarantees of quality and consistency to the consumer. The three key concepts associated with the programme are: i) Programme Standards, including breed, feed, welfare, environment, etc; ii) Control system: inspection of farms, slaughterhouses, processors and butchers; and iii) Traceability and final labelling.

**Extensive Bovine meat of Quality VEC:** the breeder and cattle dealers of the Native Pure Races Avileña Iberian Negra, Morucha and Retinta, have grouped under the abbreviations TIME (Bovine Meat of Extensive of Quality). The objective of this collaboration is to establish an image of quality products, carrying out the control, processing and production of beef in optimal conditions.

In the context of this report, the previous quality signals considered as OLP have been classified in:

- ?? Geographic Designations that included the Designation of Origin and the Geographic Indication regulated by the EU regulation 2081/92 or the corresponding Spanish regulation.
- ?? Organic farming
- ?? Geographic Quality Labels regulated by the Spanish Ley de Marcas, 1988

## 2. General Information

The available information in Spain on those three different OLP is not homogenous and scarce in the case of Geographic Quality Labels. Therefore, in this section only some figures on Spanish food consumption, Geographic Designations products and organic farming for the last available year provided by the Spanish Ministry of Agriculture (MAPA) are shown. This will give a general picture of the agro-food and quality food sector importance in Spain (available data does not allow to follow the recommended guideline). In section 3, we will try to follow as much as possible those guidelines.

### 2.1. Food consumption in Spain

Food consumption and diet is a complex biological, nutritional and also socio-cultural phenomenon. Today, in developed countries, food consumption is determined more for pleasure and desire than for necessity. The major economic, demographic, social and cultural changes that have taken place in Spain have induced significant variations

in diet and food consumption structure. The Spanish Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (MAPA) of Spain says that although these modifications have shifted the Spanish diet towards the dietary patterns of the Northern European countries, it may still be stated that it can be considered as a “Mediterranean diet”.

Table 1 shows the expenditure on food products in Spain in 1999. Total food expenditure accounted for 8.8 billion pesetas which represents an increase of 2.4% increase in current ptas. and a drop of 0.6% in constant ptas from the previous year

## 2.2. Protected Labelled products

The Spanish Ministry of Agriculture (MAPA) provides only information on Geographic Designation (PDO or IGP) which have been ratified at national level (although there are not yet included in the European Registration) and for organic farming. Information on Geographic Quality Labels is not available.

### Geographic Designations

Table 2 shows the number of Geographic Designation, area or number of animals and sales for quality wines produced in specified regions, spirit drinks, and the rest of agro-food products with designation of origin and specific designation for 1999. Table 3 gives the economic value of those products for 1999.
